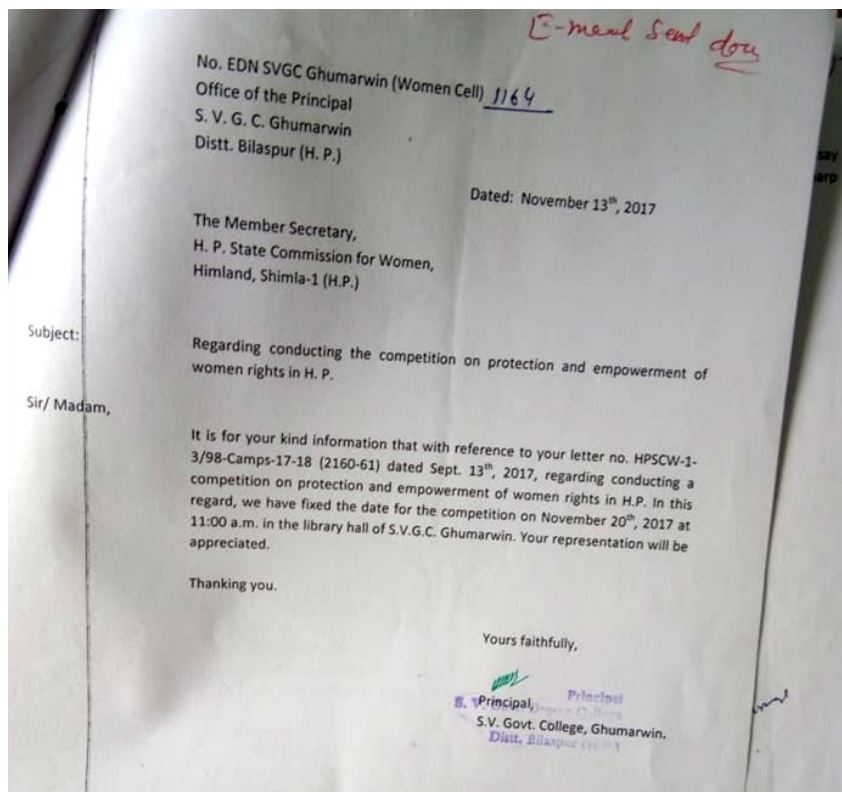


Figure 4 Report Submitted HPSCW

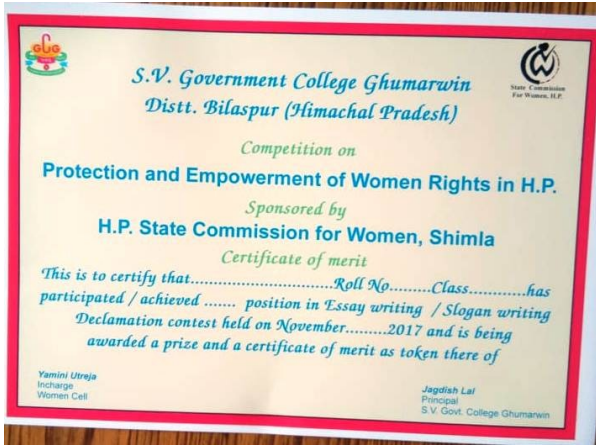


Figure 6 Certificate Issued to Participant

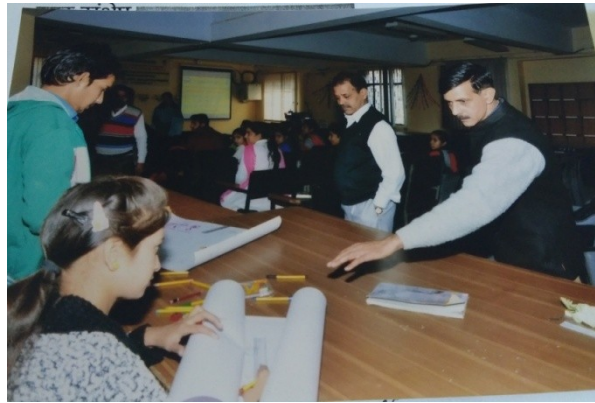


Figure 7 Judges in action




