7	Regarding Industrial Visits of the Students	Students of BBA & BCA got industry exposure through industrial visits/training. Students of the departments of Botany and Zoology also visited CSIR-IHBT Palampur in month of March.
8	Regarding the Infrastructure	a) Construction of the Commerce Block has been completed and classes have been started in this new building. b) Efforts are being made for speeding up the construction work of Science Block and P.G. Blocks.
9	Creation of Post of Professor	Correspondence with higher authorities is being done from time to time
10	Provision of Additional Infrastructure	The institution converted five existing rooms into classrooms which were earlier being used for some other purposes. 300 new desks and 10 lecture stands and glass boards have been purchased.
12	Playground Facilities	The institution has received a fund of rupees 65 lakhs approximately for the development of a playground and the work is under progress.
