This college being named after a great visionary, spiritual leader Swami Vivekananda has been established with the state government notification on dated July $1^{\text {st }}, 1994$ for running arts faculty only. The majestic and well designed building of the college was built by ACC and was handed over in 1999. Science and commerce faculties were started in 1998. The college is affiliated to H.P. University and was given due recognition under UGC section of 12(B) in 2008 and in 2 (F) in 2009. Two new vocational courses BCA and PGDCA were started in 2009 under self financing scheme. In the year 2012 M.A. English was started. In the same year another vocational course BBA was started under self financing scheme. In the year 2019, NAAC team visited the college and the institution was accredited as "B grade" institution. Three more PG courses M.Sc. Chemistry, Botany and zoology were introduced in 2020. At present the college is spread over 73.11 bighas of land the entire campus of college is under CCTV surveillance and is connected to Wi-Fi and broadband internet system. During covid-19 pandemic all necessary SOP followed by institute.

At present about three thousand students coming from far-flung rural areas are studying in various UG and PG courses being run by this college. The college has wellfurnished laboratories in the Science faculty and also in the Departments of Geography, Music and Computer Applications. It has a girl's hostel having capacity to accommodate 91 girls' students. It has its own well-furnished gymnasium, examination hall, conference hall and Boxing ring.
The college has a well-stocked library. The library has been shifted to a new building. The construction work of the new commerce block has processed.

The college is dedicated to the cause of learning by imparting education to inculcate a sense of responsibility devotional service among the students. The college provides a blend of academic, cultural, sports and intellectual resources. It also brings to the students a dynamic environment for the overall development of their personalities, aspirations and talents. In nut shell today, the college is known as one among the finest institutions in the state for Sciences, Humanities and Commerce... Over the years, the college has shown consistently very good results as compared to H.P.U. passpercentage and every year students of this college get positions in the merit list is notified by H.P.

## METHODOLOGY

The main aim of this study was to assess the satisfaction level of college students regarding campus facilities and teaching-learning process being adopted by the SVGC Ghumarwin so that necessary steps may be taken to provide better quality of education to existing and potential students. This study focused on Existing students, Alumni, Parents and Teachers. Hence population for this study constitute existing students of this college enrolled during academic session 2022-23, their parents, alumni and teachers serving during this session in the college. This study is mainly based on primary data and it has been collected using convenient cum snow ball sampling by developing structured questionnaire through Google form

## SAMPLING DESIGN

Convenient cum snow ball sampling has been used to collect desired information as per following sampling detail:

## Section-IV

## CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

The present survey has been undertaken with the objectives to study the perception and satisfaction level of students and alumni towards campus facilities and the teachinglearning process of SwamiVivekanand Government College Ghumarwin and to check the perception and satisfaction level of teachers towards different aspects of the curriculum taught by them. The present survey is based on an overall sample of 691 respondents including students, alumni, Parents and teachers of different departments of SVGCGhumarwin during 2022-23.The results of this survey are summarized as under:

Student survey analysis shows that most of the students are satisfied with college infrastructure facilities except internet/Wi-Fi facilities and library seating capacity. Students are satisfied with the teacher's ability to communicate through online mode and to encouraged and motivated for online engagement and learning. The most of students agreed with the statement that the assessment and Examination System of the college is very good and that the internal assessment was fair as per their performance. The majority of teachers prefer lectures to explain everything in realtime class. Teachers and students both prefer the Google Meet platform for online teaching whereas most of the teachers face challenges like a Lack of response from students, high absenteeism, and poor internet connectivity. From Alumni feedback analysis we found that they are highly satisfied with the amenities provided by the institution and the institution also has a positive public image. Parents are content with online teaching and stressed over taking online tests, assignments, and quizzes regularly. The majority of the teachers showed dissatisfaction with course contents in the context of employability skills and showed a strong need to start some additional value-added job-oriented courses in the existing curriculum. Most of the respondents have labeled the SVGC Ghumarwin as the best college in the area and growing well as
per its core values. There is a cordial teaching-learning environment in the institution as a result of:

1. Meeting the idiosyncratic needs of students and faculties for improved performance.
2. Supporting with resources and Providing useful feedback at the appropriate level and time
3. Modeling a belief that individuals in the organization can grow and improve with support and targeted professional development.

## Suggestions

## Suggestions are received from stakeholders (Students, Teachers, Alumni and parents)

1) Teacher-Student taught ratio should be improved for better quality education.
2) Library seating capacity should be increased.
3) E-library facilities should be developed (Access to reputed Journals/ Books/ Magazines )
4) Separate Building and Labs should be for the post-graduation courses.
5) Virtual Smart classrooms should be there for each department for online teaching.
6) Online tests, Assignments, and Presentations should be taken into practice regularly.
7) Sports infrastructure needs to be enhanced (Playground for Track \&Field Events).
8) The institution must have an App or Website for online teaching and a server for data handling / storage which facilitate students to access study material anytime.
9) There should be an online teaching training programme for teachers by the institution so that they can effectively take online classes.
10) Job oriented courses / programmeshould be introduced by the institution.

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## Action Taken Report
