















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# IOAC Meeting

The agenda of the meeting was to prepare a plan for different academic, extra-curricular and development activities to be carried out during the academic session 2022-23. The following points were discussed in the meeting:

- (A) Infrastructure :
- (1) It was decided that IT labs will be upgraded. New computers, accessories and furniture will be purchased with an approximate budget of Rs 11 lacs.
  - (2) Commerce Department will be shifted to new Commerce Block and Commerce lab will be made functional. Cabin for teachers will be constructed in the New Commerce Block.
  - (3) For Geography lab new chairs and tables will be purchased. A smart board will be installed and the internet facility will be provided.
  - (4) New stools for Botany lab will be purchased.
  - (5) A pucca/concrete pathway for new commerce block will be constructed as presently there is no proper walking way and it is difficult to reach the new building during rains.
- (B) New Courses : Short term courses like Tally will be started with the help of NIELIT or Skill Development Corporation of Himachal Pradesh. The probability of similar kind of courses in other subjects will be explored.
- (C) Seminars/Workshops/Conferences : Efforts will be made to organise college level, state level or National level seminars, conferences or workshops.



in the college. Computer department will organise some faculty development programme for teaching and non teaching staff of the college.

- (D) Sports: for strengthening of sports facilities
- 1) Repair work in Indoor Stadium will be undertaken.
  - 2) Repair work of Basket Ball ground will be taken up.
  - 3) Communication with relevant departments/agencies will be made for levelling work of the play ground and cutting of the trees etc for speeding up the construction process.

- (E) Extra-curricular Activities:
- 1) New music instruments will be purchased and the old ones will be repaired. Instruments for Folk Orchestra will be purchased.
  - 2) Near the stage a 'Green Room' will be constructed from the college building fund.
  - 3) NCC, NSS, Rovers & Rangers and all clubs and societies will keep on organising different for awareness or celebration of different special days/occasions like the previous academic session. Each of these will organise at least two activities during the current academic session.

- (F) Feedback from Students: Feedback from the students will be taken from time to time. They will be encouraged to give suggestions with student welfare and other college affairs. At the end of academic feedback like previous years will be taken from students and their



parents.

(G) New facilities to the Students :

- 1) With the help of PTA new Wi-fi Routers will be installed in the college campus.
- 2) E-library will be made functional as soon as possible. For e-library a budget of Rs 29 lac has been sent to Department of Higher Education for approvals.
- 3) Registration of students for IFLIBNET portal will be done to provide access to the e-resources.
- 4) 5 Smart Class rooms are proposed to be made in the college.

(H) Proposal for creation of additional teaching and non teaching posts will be sent to Directorate of Higher Education, Himachal Pradesh, keeping in view the increased workload after starting of new PG courses in the college.

(I) Green Energy Initiative: An additional solar plant will be installed and efforts will be made for the use maximum solar energy.

(J) Water sprinklers will be installed in in the lawns and the garden.

(K) Efforts will be made to speed up the construction work of New Science and PG Blocks.

(L) Matter of inclusion of the college under "Utkrisht Maha-Vidyalaya Scheme" of Govt of N.P. will be taken up with higher authorities on priority basis.
