



- Deletion: One student (node) was removed, and the connections were updated to show how nodes are deleted in a linked list without disrupting the entire structure.


Learning Outcomes:

2. Selection Process of SSB (Services Selection Board):


- The resource person provided a step-by-step breakdown of the SSB selection process, which evaluates candidates based on psychological aptitude, leadership skills, and physical fitness.

3. Motivational Insights:


- Subedar Major Bhupinder Singh Jaswal shared his personal experiences. motivating cadets to pursue careers in the defense sector with dedication and perseverance.


