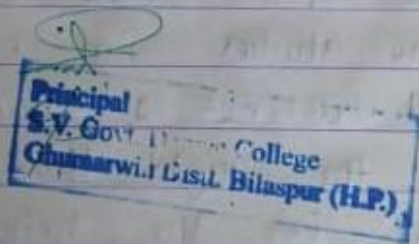



**Report on MCA Preparation Lecture**



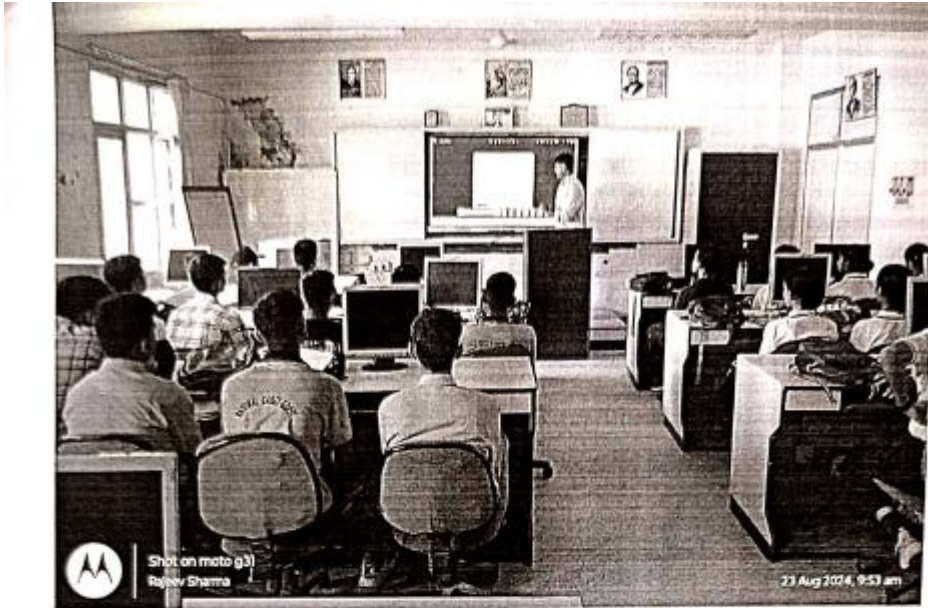
#### Key Highlights of the Lecture:

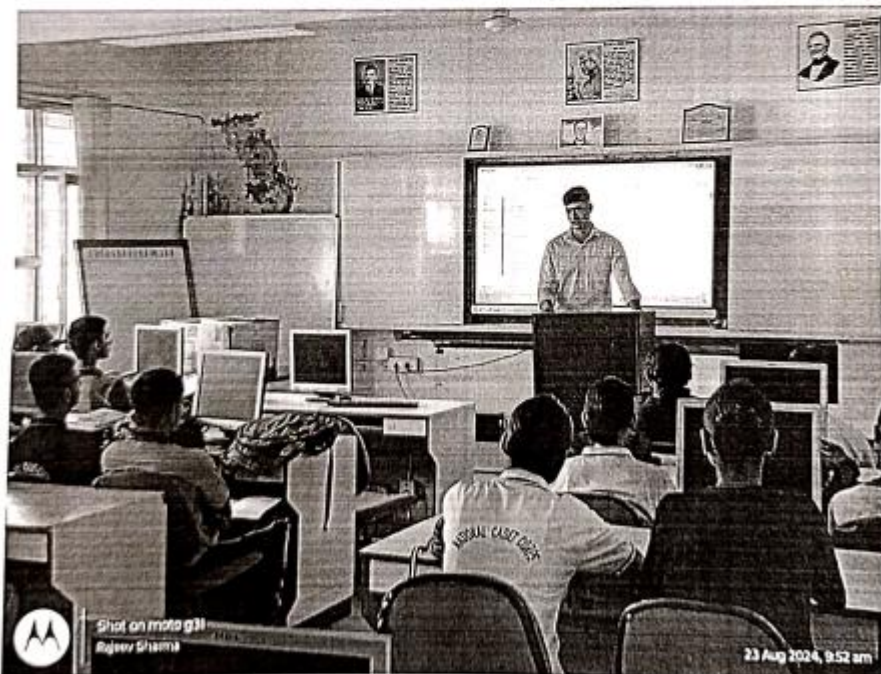

## Mentoring Activity

### Report on Activity: Creative Learning on Linked List Data Structure Implementation Using Human Nodes

**Date of Activity:** 17th September 2024

**Venue:** SVGC Ghumarwin

**Participants:** 15 Final Year B.Sc. Students

**Incharge:** Prof. Rajeev Sharma

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On 17th September 2024, a creative learning activity was conducted for the final year B.Sc. students of SVGC Ghumarwin under the supervision of **Prof. Rajeev Sharma**. The session was focused on the practical understanding of **Linked List Data Structures** by using a unique approach where students represented nodes of a linked list.

#### **Objective:**

The primary goal of the activity was to provide an interactive and engaging method for students to understand the concept of a **Linked List**, which is a fundamental data structure in computer science. This activity emphasized how nodes (students) are connected via pointers (links) to form a linked list.

#### **Methodology:**

- **Human Nodes:** Each student represented a node in a linked list.
  - **Pointers:** Students used physical objects like strings or ribbons to simulate the pointers connecting them to the next node.
  - **Node Operations:** Different operations such as insertion, deletion, and traversal were demonstrated using students moving to mimic these processes.
1. **Traversal:** Students passed an object (symbolizing data) from the head node to the next node and so on, showing how data is accessed in a linked list.
  2. **Insertion:** A new student was added in between two nodes by adjusting the connections (pointers), illustrating how a new node is inserted.
  3. **Deletion:** One student (node) was removed, and the connections were updated to show how nodes are deleted in a linked list without disrupting the entire structure.

#### **Learning Outcomes:**

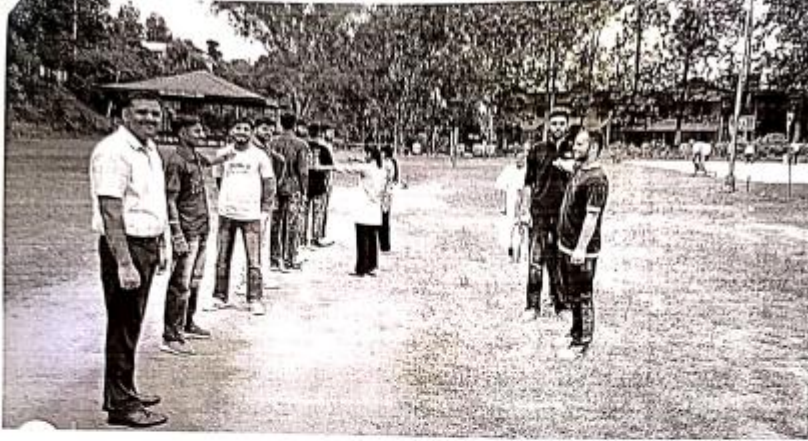
- Students gained a hands-on understanding of how linked lists work, including key operations such as **insertion, deletion, and traversal**.
- The practical implementation using human nodes helped reinforce theoretical knowledge and made complex concepts easier to grasp.

- The importance of staying calm, confident, and disciplined throughout the process was highlighted.

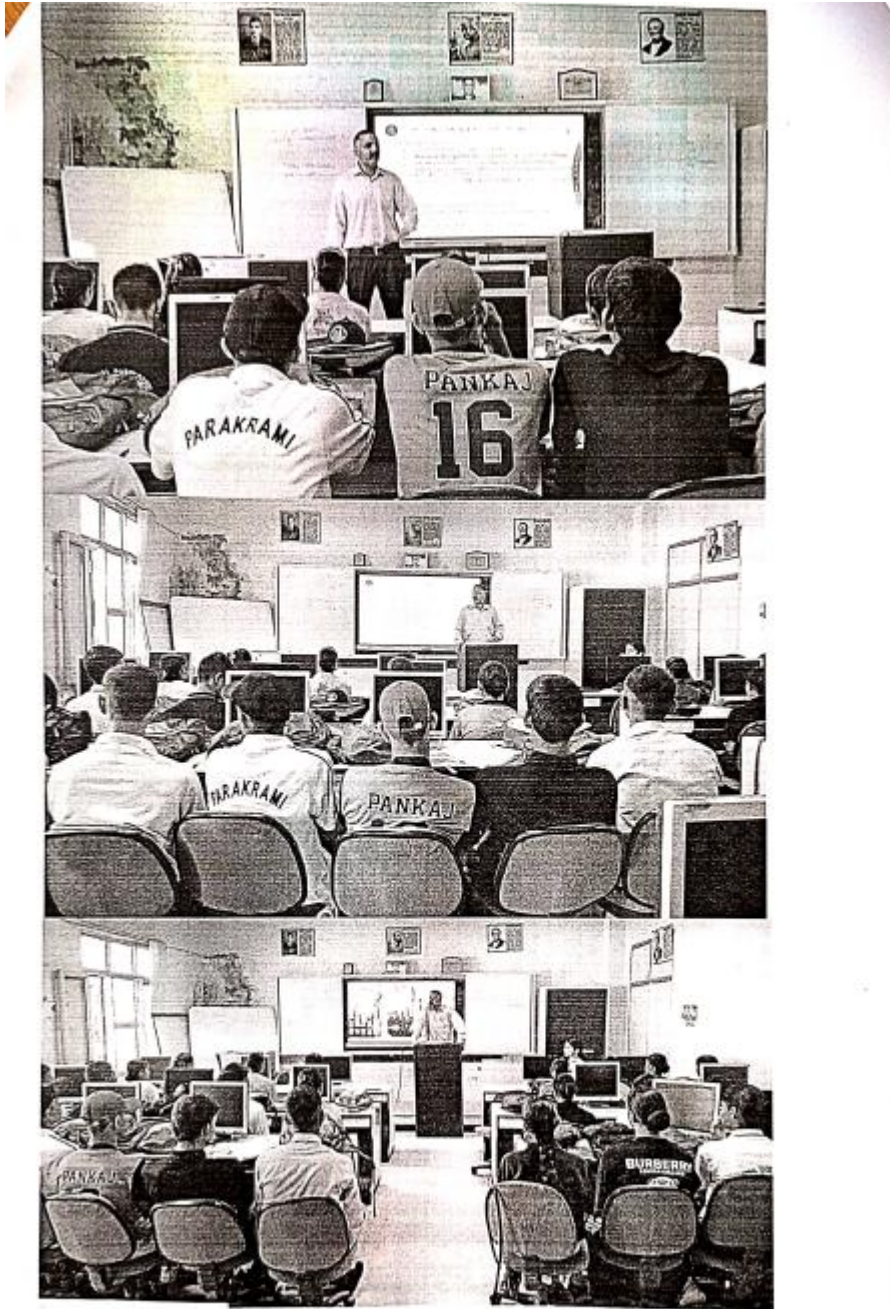
##### **3. Motivational Insights:**
